In Google and other search engine's advanced setup, you may be asked to provide a sitemap of your website. You can access your website's sitemap by visiting the following URL:

- <https://web.membervnova.com/#####/sitemap.xml>
  - Replace ##### with the number reflecting your own MemberNova website.

For websites which use a custom domain name instead of the generic MemberNova address, you can access your sitemap by visiting:

- [customdomain.tld/sitemap.xml](http://customdomain.tld/sitemap.xml)
  - Example: If your homepage URL is: [www.mymembervnova.com](http://www.mymembervnova.com) then the sitemap would be found at: [www.mymembervnova.com/sitemap.xml](http://www.mymembervnova.com/sitemap.xml)
